Dave Gross Wins “The Viper Challenge”

Since, last August forty-one players qualified, for the \$4,000 purse 10-ball event that was held this last weekend March 28-29, 2009. The tournament was held at the Wynkoop Brewing Company located at 1634 18th Street, Denver, CO 80202. This exclusive tournament was built for 15-rack league players only.

Dave Gross went undefeated to be crowned the ultimate 15-Rack Champion- he had wins over Shane Wertz, Mark Haddad, Melissa Little, and Jeff Crawford. Mark Haddad lost to Dave in the winner’s side early Sunday but then came back with a vengeance to make it in the finals with Dave Gross- Fortunately for Dave; he escaped a loss and beat Mark in the finals to capture the tournament title and be crowned the champion. Jenny Neuhalfen was crowned “highest finishing female” winning a gorgeous trophy and pocketed a \$200 bonus for her efforts. Great job, Jenny!

How to play 15-Rack?

Get into random groups of three, in turn each player breaks 10-balls and tries to run-out the balls with "ball in hand" for fifteen racks per night. Handicaps: A's: take zero off the top of the rack, B's: picks one ball off the top of the rack, C's: picks two balls off the top of the rack and D's: pick three balls off the top of the rack.
