



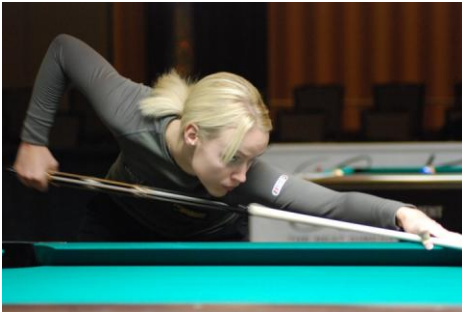

WPBA PRO'S ALLISON FISHER & JASMIN OUSCHAN SET TO PLAY FINALS IN WORLD GAMES

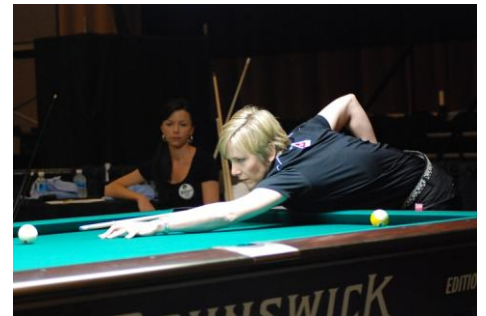
BOTH PLAYERS VYING FOR THE GOLD MEDAL IN KAOHSIUNG, CHINA

July 25th, 2009 – The World Games Billiards Division kicked off this week with five 2009 WPBA Exempt Professional's competing for the ultimate prize, the Gold Medal. Vivian Villarreal won her first round match against Estelle Bijnen but lost to Yuan-Chun Lin. Ga Young Kim matched up versus Line Kjorsvik and found the Norwegian too tough, with Line winning 9-6. Allison Fisher played her first round against Apsra Panchoo from South Africa and won 9-3 while Jasmin Ouschan played Amalia Matas from Spain and defeated her 9-4.

Jeanette Lee defeated Carlyn Sanchez Torrealba and Jeanette joined three of her fellow WPBA players who advanced to the final eight. For the second round, Allison played a tactical battle against the legendary Taiwanese, Shin-Mei Liu, and won 9-5. In a less than perfect match on both sides, Jasmin went head-to-head against former Gold medalist, Jeanette Lee, and won 9-5. Moving on into the final four on Saturday; Allison was paired against the 2008



World 9-Ball Champion from Taiwan, Yuan-Chun Lin, a player that had handed Allison a third place medal after beating her 9-7 in the 2008 World Championships. But Allison would change the tide by defeating Y.C. Lin 9-5. Jasmin was up against Shu-Han "Cherie" Chang, a young Chinese Taipei player, who is a fast & fearless opponent. Chang came off a very close match in the final eight against Norway's, Line Kjorsvik. Line was down 5-1 in the match and played near flawless pool to make it 8-8, but lost in the final game. Jasmin went on to dominate Chang and won 9-2. In the third - fourth place match, Y.C. Lin defeated Chang to take home the Bronze medal. The final match between Allison and Jasmin will be 11AM Kaohsiung time (or 11PM EST).
